



Huller & Cheese Warehouse, Bristol

This design and build contract involved the conversion/refurbishment and extension of Huller House and the Cheese Warehouse into 50 residential high spec apartments on Redcliffe Backs in Bristol.

Huller House is a Grade II listed building and the Cheese Warehouse has been identified as a building of special architectural merit due to its unique Hennebique reinforced concrete structure.

The development comprises five floors of one, two and three bedroom apartments converted from the existing warehouse, with an extra two floors of new build development to the Cheese Warehouse and a single new build level to Huller House.

Other works included altered site access, vehicle parking, refuse storage, and landscaping. The new development has been designed and built to BREEAM Very Good requirements.
